<b>Plan</b>	<p>Data collection confirm number of bins on site</p> <p>Visually audit &amp; Calculate total cubic meters of waste generated by school:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Record waste bin 'fill volumes' prior to emptying</li> <li>Record number of bin emptying services per week</li> <li>Record number of waste 'burn-offs' per week <i>(if burning waste on school grounds)</i></li> </ul> <p>Review the actual bin service requirements for school and make recommendations</p> <p>Review existing waste service schedule</p> <p>Give consideration to identifying 'reusable' or 'recyclable' materials <i>(reusing other sides of writing paper, recycling of plastic food containers and drink containers, recycling material voluntary drop-offs, etc)</i></p> <p>If necessary make arrangements for renewed service contract (obtain comparable quotes, etc)</p> <p>Identify / confirm roles &amp; responsibilities during implementation trial period</p>		
<b>OH&amp;S</b>	<p>Low risk lifting (bend knees, keep back straight)</p> <p>Do not inhale when looking inside bulk bins (microbiological hazards)</p> <p>Do not stand on milk crates to visually inspect bulk bins (fall hazard)</p>		
<b>KPI's</b>	Introduction of a 'No Burn' policy – CO2 reduction contribution
